Team Wellington FC was formed in 2004 by a consortium of Wellington clubs to compete in the NZ Football Championship.

In the inaugural season (2004/2005), they performed below expectations, Finishing sixth. They improved in the next season, ending in forth place.

In March 2016, Team Wellington won their first ever premiership title. Having Finished in third in the regular season, they beat Hawkes Bay United in the Semi-final, before beating Auckland City 4 - 2 in the final.

Team Wellington won back to back league titles in 2017, dispatching Waitakere United on penalties after an enthralling 6 - 6 draw in the semi-final, before Beating Auckland City 2 - 1 in the final at QBE Stadium in Albany.
