

the Football South Federation. Otago United Incorporated (the name until 2103)
was formed by 21 clubs within the Football South Federation, from Timaru to
Invercargill.


Based in Dunedin, being the sole representative from Federation 7, the club was originally named Otago United Incorporated for the first 9 years of its history. During the 2013/14 season, Otago United Incorporated changed its name to Southern United FC Incorporated (Southern United FC) on 16 August 2013, to better reflect the wide geographical area which it covers. The area covered by Southern United FC includes Southland, Otago and South Canterbury.

The squad this year has a fresh look from last season, with a number of new faces joining the team from both within and outside the Football South region. They join a core of eleven players returning from last season's campaign.
